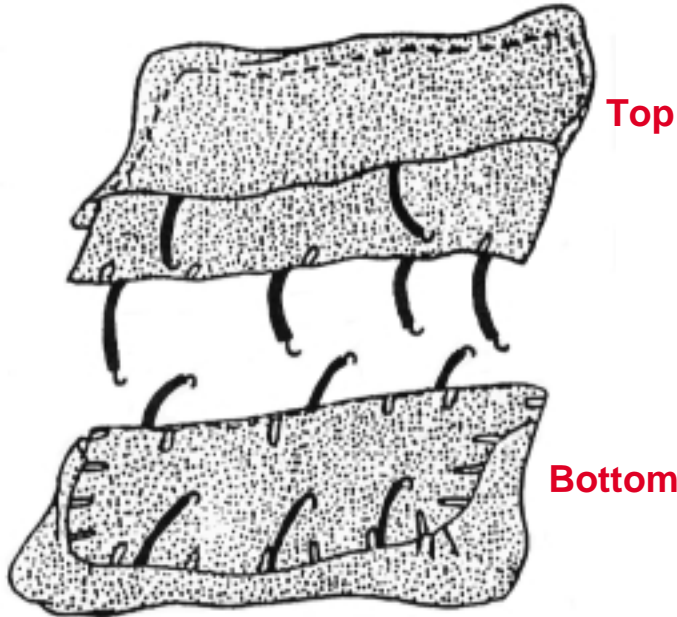


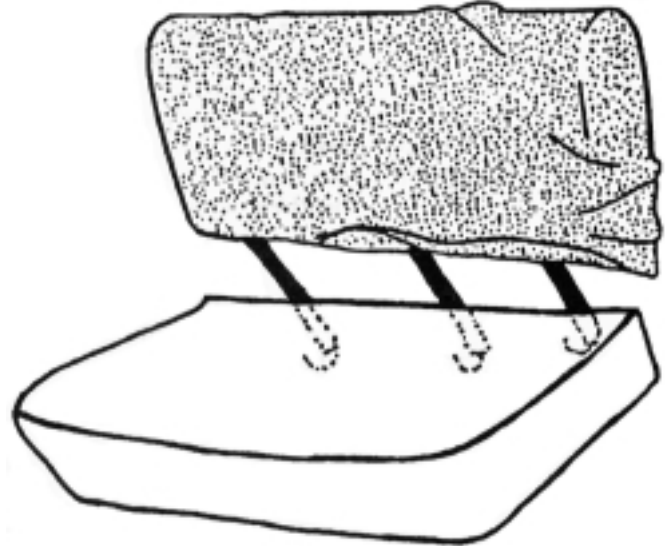
# Bench Seat Cover Installation Instructions

Your new Cloud Nine Sheepskin bench seat cover is made to fit like a glove. For the best possible fit, refer to the installation suggestions listed on this sheet.

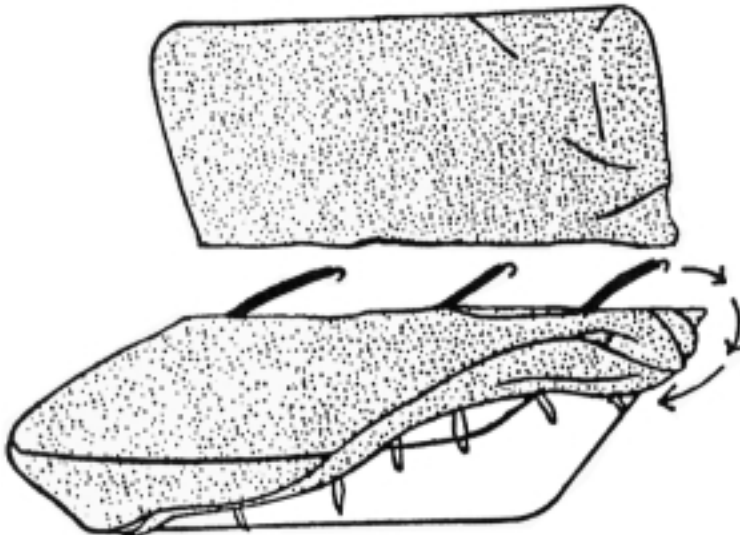
**Step 1.** Lay the cover flat. Identify the top and bottom parts of the bench seat cover. If there are headrests and other hardware, you must first remove them.



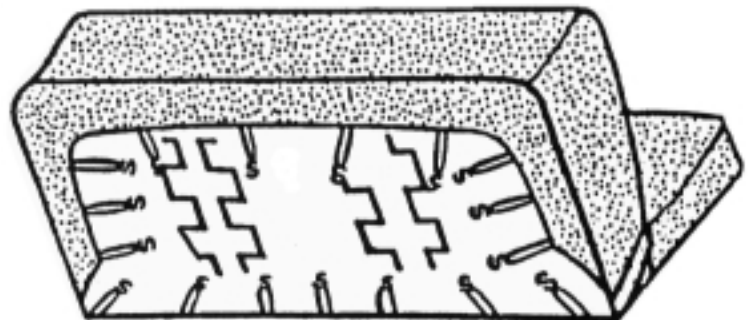
**Step 2.** Pull the hood of the top half of the bench seat cover over the top of the seat. Smooth the cover to fit the backrest by pushing the cover between the seat and backrest. Pull the straps between the seat and backrest and **CAREFULLY** attach the hooked straps to the bottom of the seat.



**Step 3.** Slip the bottom half of the bench cover on by pulling the skirting material over the front of the seat. Smooth the creases out to the sides. Push the cover between the seat and the backrest and pull the straps through the backside of the seat.



**Step 4.** (Note: Now is the time to make slits for the seat belts to pass through, if necessary). Make a small slit with a sharp instrument just large enough for the seat belt to pass through. This will not hurt the bench cover. We suggest putting duct tape behind the slits to reinforce them. Now **CAREFULLY** attach the hooked straps to the underside of the seat. Make slits for the headrest holes and other hardware items, if you have them.



## 1 Year Limited Warranty

Cloud Nine Sheepskin™ seat covers are warranted to be free from defective materials or workmanship for a period of 1 year from the date of purchase. **Please Note:** Since color dyes may change or fade, this sheepskin seat cover will not be replaced for, or otherwise warranted against any change in color. A possible marking of color could occur when dark colored seats are fitted to a light colored upholstery. Under these circumstances, we suggest that a piece of cloth be placed between the seat and the cover to prevent any possible discoloration. Purchaser assumes responsibility. We do not recommend washing and do not warranty covers that have been washed.
